Drawing on input from gatherings of clergy, agency and community leaders throughout the 20-county Atlanta metro area, the Regional Council of Churches of Atlanta (RCCA) has identified common issues of concern across the region, and formulated a plan of action to address them. The Council establishes yearly objectives that can be achieved through the collaborative efforts of its diverse Christian member network of religious and community organizations and individuals.

RCCA's 2004 initiatives are focused on collective outreach to serve those who live in poverty in our region, through the following efforts:

- *Action* - Encouraging clusters of local congregations to work collaboratively to improve the impact of their mission in their neighborhoods;
- *Education*—Fostering understanding and dialogue on the emergence of the new face of poverty in suburban and exurban areas, and highlighting the importance and potential impact of cooperative Christian outreach in response to this issue;
- *Communication*—Establishing interaction between ministries, faith based groups and the community at large to encourage cooperative efforts in addressing the problem of poverty and the working poor.
